Edward Allan Guthmueller

Edward Allan Guthmueller, 91, of Branson, MO, formerly of Tioga, passed away on January 10, 2022 in Branson, MO.

Edward was born on Nov 14, 1930 in Merricourt, ND to Edward and Flora Guthmueller. He was the 4th of 7 children having 3 older sisters Phyllis, Mavis and Lois, followed by brother Louis, sister Shirley, and his youngest brother, Eugene. He was raised in Edgely and Kulm, graduating with the class of 1948. He attended the State School of Forestry from 1948-1950, graduating with a degree in forestry. Upon graduating, he joined the Navy and served from 1950-1951.

After leaving the Navy he went to work for Amerada Petroleum Company as a field clerk in 1952, in Tioga, where he met Shirley Schroeder whom he married on October 17, 1953. They had 3 children, Terry, Debbie, and Rodney, all born in the hospital in Powers Lake, ND.
