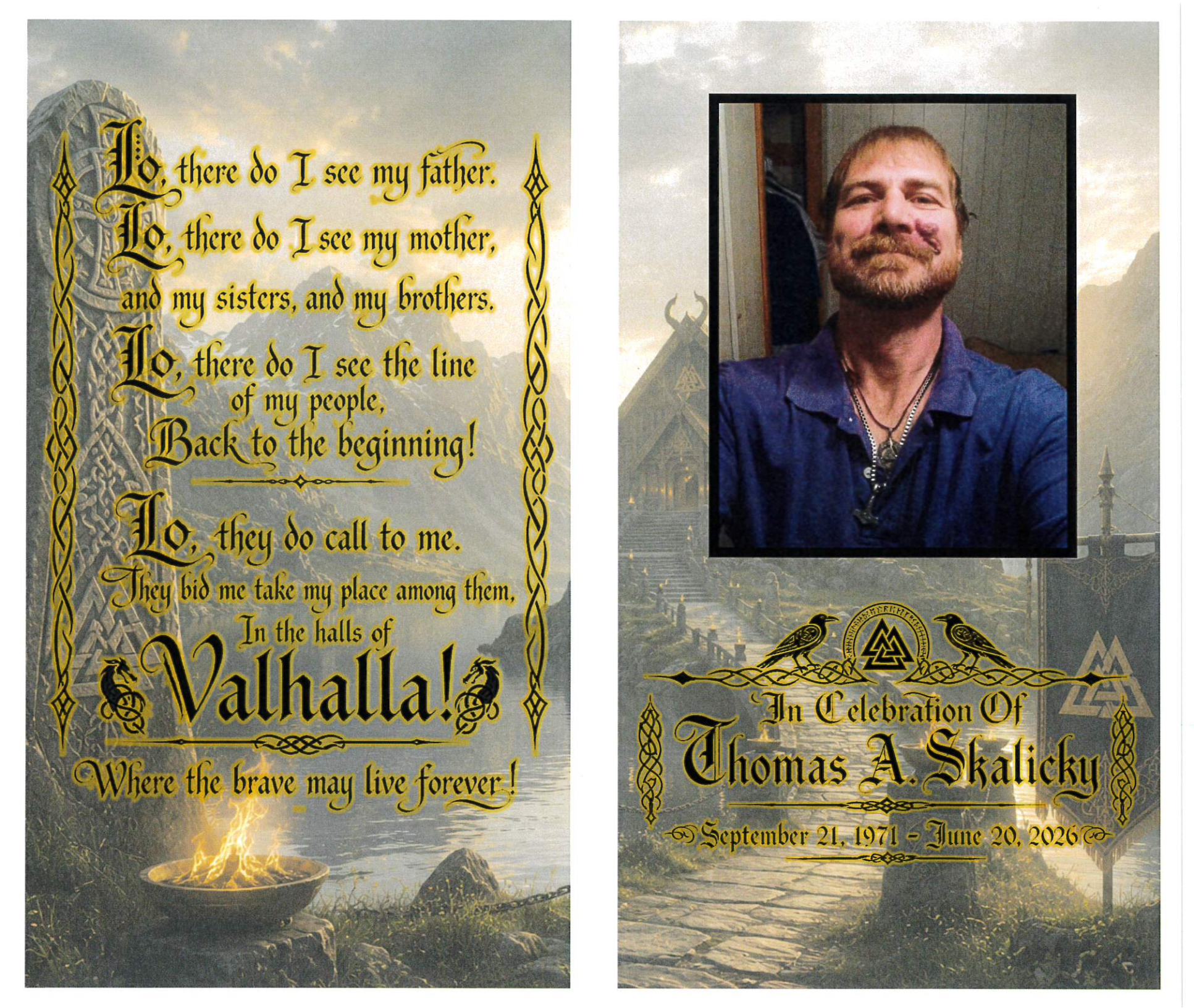




Lo, there do I see my father.
