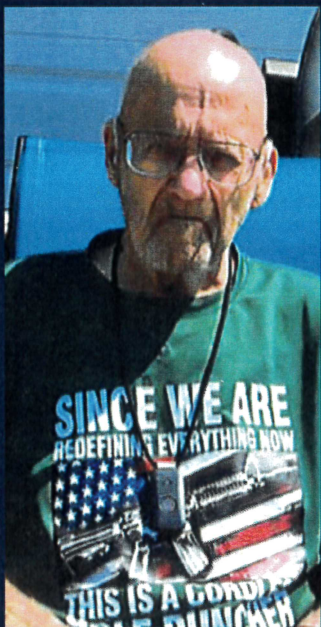

Larry A. Maize, 81, of Tioga, ND passed away on June 30, 2026 at the Tioga Medical Center.
