He'll fill that place within your heart, and cleanse you free from sin.

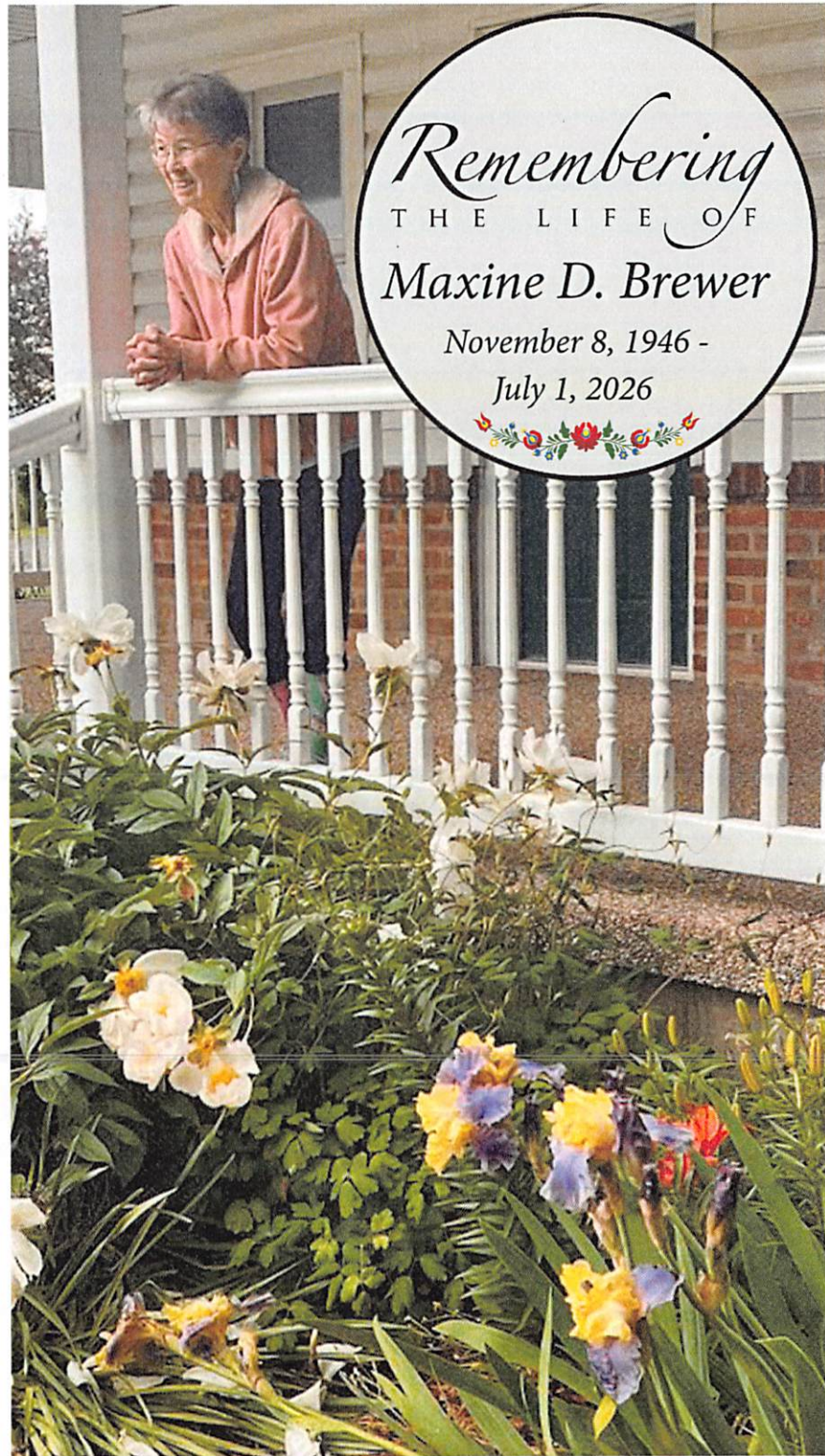
Oh, what a joy to know Him, to let Him be your guide.
