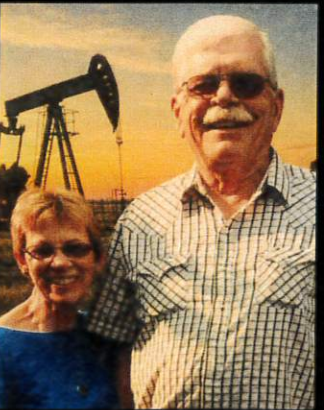




Jerry M. Grev, 81, of Williston, North Dakota, passed away on August 31, 2026 in Fargo, North Dakota.

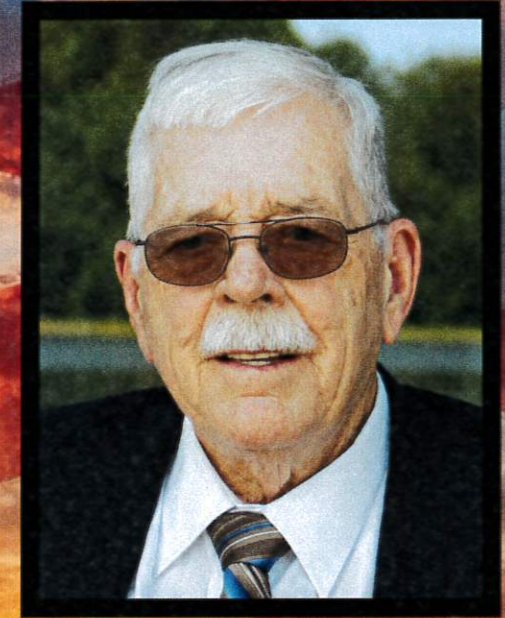

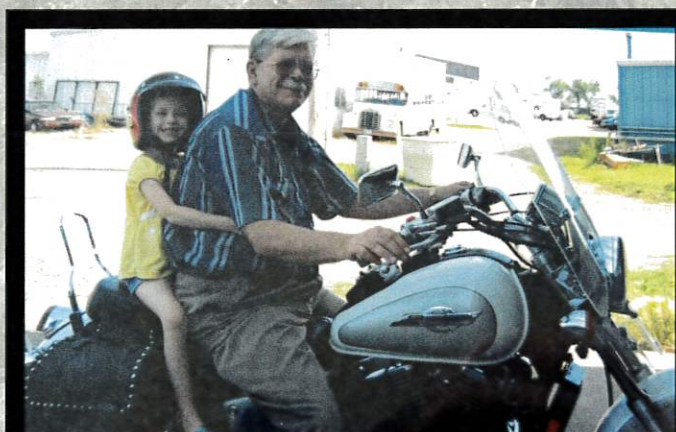
